**Friday, 7:30 PM** – Ritual Gathering and Blessing, Wild Hunt and Wicker Man - Join us for our 6th annual Wild Hunt! We will tell the story of the Flight and the Stone. We will burn the Wicker Man to welcome the Spring and bring back the day. Glow sticks are provided, all mobility levels welcome.

**Saturday, 7:00 AM** – Dragon Wake-Up Chanting Workshop – Start your Saturday with warmth, laughter, and a little mythical mischief! Grab your morning coffee and gather around the fire as Alfred Willowhawk leads us in a lively, heart-opening chanting session designed to rouse our sleepy, slightly grumpy dragon and set the tone for a joyful festival.

**Saturday, 2:45 PM** – **[18+]** OTO Gnostic Mass - Liber XV, the Gnostic Mass, is the central ritual, public and private, of Ordo Templi Orientis.
